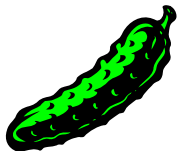


Legal Statement

For consideration of the acceptance of my application for the Pickle Bucket Boat Races event, I hereby freely agree to and make the following contractual representation and agreements. I fully realize and assume the risks associated with participating in this competition.

I hereby waive, release and discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assigns and Successors in interest (herein after collectively called "Successors") any and all rights and claims which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me against The White Bear Lake Lions Club, The State of Minnesota, City of White Bear Lake, Ramsey County, the event organizer and any promoting organization(s), property owners, law enforcement agencies, all public entities, special districts, and properties (and their respective agents, parent or affiliate companies, officials and employees) through or by which the events will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with the event, or travel to or return from the event.

I agree that it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the grounds and any special regulations for this event. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the race, which may be beyond the immediate control of the contest officials or organizers, and I must continually act so as to endanger neither myself nor others. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment. I have no physical or mental condition, which to my knowledge would endanger myself or others if I participate in the event, or would interfere with my ability to participate in this event.



The White Bear Lake Lions Club reserves the right to photograph the event and its participants for publicity purposes.

I agree, for myself and my Successors, that the above representations are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals, and that should I or my Successors assert my claim in contravention of this agreement, I or my Successors shall be liable for the expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the other party or parties in defending, unless the other party or parties are finally adjudged liable on such claim for willful and wanton negligence. This agreement may not be modified orally, and a waiver of any provision shall not be construed as a modification of any other provisions herein or as a consent to any subsequent waiver or modification.



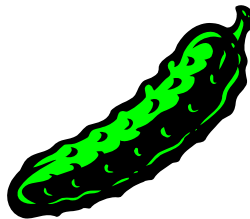

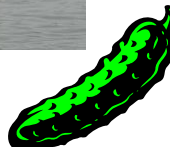
1. The flotation for the vessel must contain of whole, plastic, 5 gallon buckets (not ice cream gallons). Wood, plastic, nails and screws may be used to join the buckets, but at least half (50%) of the original bucket must be exposed to water. You may not completely wrap the flotation surface.
2. The use of fixed oars and mechanical devices is encouraged for all races. The only motorized devices allowed are electric motors with one 12 volt battery max. Boats using gas motors will be disqualified.
3. Each crew member must provide and wear a Coast Guard approved flotation device. Ski belts are not acceptable.
4. Each crew member must wear shoes. Either tennis shoes or boat shoes, something that stays on your feet. Flip flops are unacceptable
5. Race number stickers (received at registration tent on site) MUST be visible on ALL boats.
6. The crew is required to transport the boat or its remains home, or feed it to the garbage bin.
7. A boat may only be entered once in each race.
8. Boats may be inspected for compliance with the rules. The judges decisions are final.
9. A registration form must be completed and a waiver must be signed for each person, for each race.
10. All boats must be registered one hour prior to the published time.



The Registration Fee is \$50.00 per boat. (This includes six 5 gallon buckets with sealed lids)

Each bucket floats approximately 40 lbs (up to 10 buckets more may be purchased at \$6.00 per bucket)

The use of ingenious materials and methods of motivation (sails, paddlewheels and other human power) is encouraged. A boat must float but need not cross the finish line to win a creative award.

Boats will be judge on speed and creativity.

Speed awards will be given to the fastest boat to cross the finish line in timed heats.

Creative awards will be based on: Originality, Creativity, Workmanship, Crew Member Costumes and Total Number of Buckets Used (the more the better).

Prizes will be awarded for both speed and creativity.

1st Place Speed both battery and other powered.

1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Creative

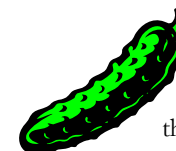
